2. GET PASSENGERS ON BOARD

3. TAKE OFF SMOOTHLY

Ask great questions

This will help you:

- break down barriers
- get to know someone better

Admire what you can about what they believe

The G.O.S.P.E.L. Message

The gospel is the good news of our loving and Holy Creator who rescues us and makes us new through the death, burial and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ. It's the power of God to change any life! Through the gospel, God reconciles sinners to Himself and makes them pass from death to life at the very moment of receiving this message wholeheartedly.

But remember, the gospel message is NOT a script we memorize and just repeat to our friends. The gospel FIRST changes us and shapes our identity. When we understand it, embrace it, and live it out, then we will have gospel conversations with the compassion and power of Jesus in us.

To help you do that, you can go through <u>the 6 key truths of the **G.O.S.P.E.L.** acrostic</u>. Read them and meditate on them as you get deeper into the Bible verses they are based upon. Then, memorize them, practice them, master them with your own words and creativity and quote the Bible verses with the love and authority that comes from God. I would recommend picking one or two Bible verses under each key point and memorize them. Or you can pick your own.

God created us to be with Him.

"Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his;" Psalm 100:3

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them." Genesis 1: 27

OUR sins separate us from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God;" Romans 3:23

EVERYONE who trusts in Him alone has eternal life.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever *believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16

"testifying both to Jews and to Greeks of repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ." Acts 20:21

*To trust or believe = repentance + faith. They are two sides of the same coin. Faith and repentance are inseparable and simultaneous. To repent is a change of mind/heart regarding sin, salvation, and our need for a savior. Through the gospel we are convicted of sin, as a wall of separation between us and God, Salvation, as there is nothing, we can do to delete our sins and save ourselves, Savior, only Jesus can give us the righteousness that we don't have. So, we put our faith in Jesus alone to be saved by grace alone.

"That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation...For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." Romans 10: 9,10,13

LIFE with Jesus starts now and last forever.

"And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. **John 17:3**

"Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment but has passed from death to life." John 5:24

- 2. What is holding you back from putting your trust in Jesus today? Listen and invite him/her to pray to Jesus with you if they are ready. If not, be sensitive and trust in God's time.
